#### Generic Selection Criteria

- a. The Applicants must be a national of one of the African Union Member States and reside in Africa at the time of Application and commencement of the training;
- b. The Applicant should be working in Health Research center or Health Facilities within Africa;
- c. Knowledge of Spoken/Written English is essential;
- d. The Applicant should not be more than 55 years old as on last day of submission of application;
- e. The Applicant must satisfy the course eligibility criteria they apply for;
- f. Must have a valid international travel document and vaccination card;
- g. Must never being convicted of any crime.
